BaamBoozle	Excellent jeopardy style game. Super fun for ALL ages.
BookCreator App	Target goals w/ interactive stories, poetry books, comics, 'about me' books, etc. Use in Google Chrome browser. Free version allows for 5 books.

Classroom Secrets	Game format targeting a variety of areas. Pick your poison!
Code	Super fun and engaging way to teach code. Use those goals and be creative! Fun to use as 5 min. Break. Target following directions, auditory comprehension.
EdPuzzle	Turn any video into active learning. Easy to use. Perfect for social skills, inferencing, and other areas of pragmatics. Let your imagination run wild!
Epic!	Digital library for amazing books, quizzes and videos. Super cool site. You'll love it I promise! Be creative w/ older students. Scaredy Squirrel is a fun series (addresses executive functioning needs to w/ many charts and visuals)
FlipGrid	Short video discussion experience to support social learning. Awesome for ALL ages!
Everyday Speech	30 day trial free. Excellent social-emotional skills lessons and videos. Easy to use remotely. Easy to save lists and send to parents for activities to do on their own. My favorite part is you literally don't have to prep at all and can use it for almost any social group. Easy for teletherapy.
Gimkit	Gimkit is a game show for the classroom that requires knowledge, collaboration, and strategy to win.
Google Earth	Create stories and expand on language. With creation tools, you can draw on the map, add your photos and videos and customize your view. Use the 'Voyager' feature for some really cool visuals. Kids love this!
Go Noodle	Great for getting students to move and practice mindfulness.
Headspace	Everyday Mindfulness and Meditation for Stress, Anxiety, Sleep, Focus, Fitness, and More. *Better than Calm in my opinion.
Jamboard	Jamboard is G Suite's digital whiteboard that offers a rich collaborative experience for small groups. You can create a Jam, edit it from your device, and share it with others. Similar to Padlet (I prefer Padlet).
Jeopardy Labs	Create your own jeopardy template online, without PowerPoint. Or browse the pre-made templates created by other people!
Kahoot	Fun game-based site. Search any topic from synonyms to Zones of Regulation.



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Kami	A great PDF and Document Annotation and Markup Tool. Works with Google Drive and Google Classroom too! Use your TpT materials here.
Learning Apps	Looks a bit cheesy on the front page, but honestly, it's pretty cool. Tons of ways to implement therapy.
Minecraft: Education Edition	A game-based learning platform that promotes creativity, collaboration, and problem-solving in an immersive digital environment.
Loom	This app/site can record your screen, voice, and face to create an instantly shareable video in less time than it would take to type an email. Similar to ScreenCastify and ScreenCastomatic, but in my opinion it's far better. Free and more storage space, easier to use.
Mentimeter	Interact with your students in small groups using real-time voting. No installations or downloads required - and it's free!
NearPod	Interactive lessons: target comprehension, categories, vocab, and more.
Newsela	Current events/articles w/ leveled reading. Target vocab and other language needs.
News2You	Tailored to help individuals with special needs access the general education curriculum. Updated weekly with current events and requires ZERO prep. Easy to tie in speech and language activities. Subscription based.
Overcoming Obstacles	A life skills curriculum that is organized into elementary, middle, and high school levels, each beginning with the three fundamental skills on which all other skills can be built: communication, decision making, and goal setting.
Padlet	From your hobby to your career, your class notes to your final exam, your mood board to your runway show, padlets are a fun way to engage students. Small to large groups.
Panorama Education	Mindfulness activities for all ages!
Pear Deck	Active learning. Integrates w/ Google Slides and makes learning fun. Create all types of language activities w/ your kiddos.
QR Stuff	A free QR code generator and QR code online creator. Tons of creation options including; YouTube link, pdf file code, Google Maps location, Instagram link, or Vcard contact information.
Quizizz	Find and create gamified quizzes, lessons, presentations, and flashcards relating to speech and language. Fun and free!
